Notification

S.R.O. 171/— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules to amend the Defence Research and Development Organisation and Directorate General of Aeronautical Quality Assurance, Ministry of Defence Accounts Cadre Recruitment Rules, 1999, namely :-

1. Short title and commencement - (1) These rules may be called the Defence Research and Development Organisation, and Directorate General of Aeronautical Quality Assurance, Ministry of Defence Accounts Cadre Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2002.
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. In the Schedule to the Defence Research and Development Organisation and Directorate General of Aeronautical Quality Assurance, Ministry of Defence Accounts Cadre Recruitment Rules, 1999, against the post of Senior Accounts Officer Grade II, for the existing columns and entries relating thereto, the following shall be substituted, namely

Promotion:-

Accounts Officer in the grade of Rs.7450-11500 with three years regular service in the grade.

Note: Where juniors who have completed their qualifying service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying service by more than half of such qualifying service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade alongwith their juniors who have already completed such qualifying service.

Deputation/Absorption:-

Officers from the organised Accounts Departments of the Central Government:-

- (a) (i) Holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre/department; or

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(ii) with two years service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on regular basis in the scale of pay Rs.7500-12000 or equivalent in the parent cadre/ department; or

(iii) With three years service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on regular basis in the scale of pay of Rs.7450-11500 or equivalent; and

(b) Possessing atleast five years experience in Accounts Matter.

Note 1:- The Departmental Officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

Note 2:- Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other Organisation/Department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed 3 years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall not be exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.
