

Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for Fair Use of 'DRDO E-journal Services'

The DRDO E-Journal Service came into being w.e.f. 01 January 2009. DRDO EJLS consortium facilitates sharing of resources and improving access to information. The resources are shared among DRDO libraries that have common missions and goals. DESIDOC is the nodal agency that administers and monitors the access/subscriptions on behalf of DRDO. To evaluate the DRDO E-Journals Service, a Monitoring Committee has been constituted by DRDO HQrs.

1. AUTHORIZED USERS

- a) Persons affiliated with Licensee as employees as decided by lab.
- b) Affiliated third party i.e. Persons affiliated with Licensee as consultants and/or contractors, where such use of the Licensed Products is only for the purposes of the contracted work for the Licensee.
- c) Persons authorized by licensee and accessing licensed products within the library facilities at the sites permitted by the Licensee; and
- d) Such other persons as the Licensor may, at the request of the Licensee and in sole discretion of the Licensor, authorized in writing to access the licensed products.

2. PERMISSIBLE USES

Licensee and its authorized users may

- a) Unlimited access, search, browse, download, print and view the licensed products;
- b) Post such articles on the secured internal website of the Licensee as may be reasonable required, provided no more than 05 no. of articles per issue of a journal are posted on the secure internal website of licensee at a given point of time.

3. RESTRICTIONS ON USES

Subscriber and its authorized users may not:

- a) Remove, obscure or modify in any way any copyright notices, other notices or disclaimers as they appear in the subscribed products.
- b) Use any robots, spider, crawlers or other automated downloading programs, algorithms or devices to continuously and automatically search, scrape, extract, deep link, index or disrupt the working of the subscribed products.
- c) Substantially or systematically reproduce, retain or redistribute the subscribed products.
- d) Users will not share the login and password details of remote access service to others.
- e) Users will not redistribute or make available access to the e-journals for any commercial purposes.
- f) Since restrictions are different from publisher to publisher, so for more details individual publisher's website needs to be visited.

4. Responsibility of DRDO Labs:

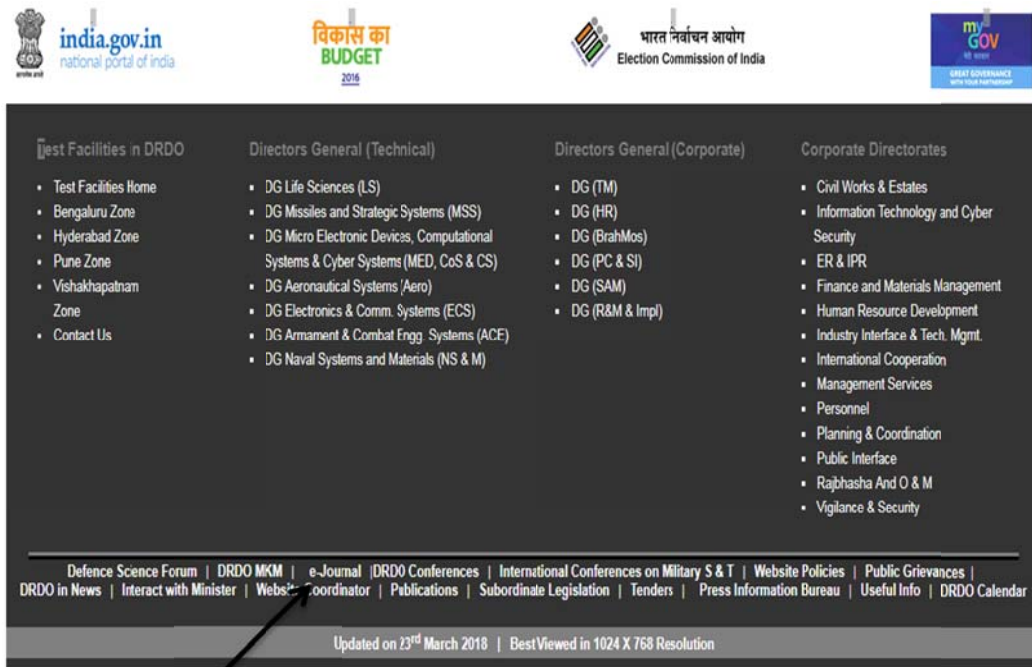
- a) If lab wants to include e-journal into “DRDO e-journal Services” Consortium, first individual lab has to subscribe journal/ periodical either print or electronic and then justify their requirement on utilization basis.
- b) A list of required e-journals recommended by Library Advisory Committee (LAC) and approved by lab Director must be reached before end of March for next year subscription i.e. for the subscription year 2019 requirement must be reached by March 2018.
- c) Since labs are demanding e-journals, so utilization of e-journals is the responsibility of individual lab only. Each lab has to ensure optimal utilization of resources.
- d) The individual/ lab shall be responsible for any violation/ infringing of copyright laws or misuse of the e-journals/ remote login.

5. **WHO CAN ACCESS:** Any subscriber lab of DRDO may access e-journals. a list of e-journals along with their lab name is available on e-journal website at URL: <http://dsl.drdo.gov.in/ejournals/home.html>

6. HOW TO ACCESS E-JOURNALS:

The following are the steps to access e-journals:

- a) Kindly visit DRDO website at URL: “www.drdo.gov.in” then scroll down to the end of the home page and then click on e-journal option, as it is displayed below.
